# MALABAR FARM

In 1939, Louis Bromfield, a native of Mansfield, Ohio, Pulitzer-Prize winning author, and pioneering conservationist purchased several farms in Richland County, Ohio and created his dream: Malabar Farm. Malabar Farm was destined to become "The Most Famous Farm in America". Bromfield built a 32 room country home known as the Big House where family, friends, and the famous could come, stay, and work while enjoying all the natural wonders that life at Malabar Farm could offer.

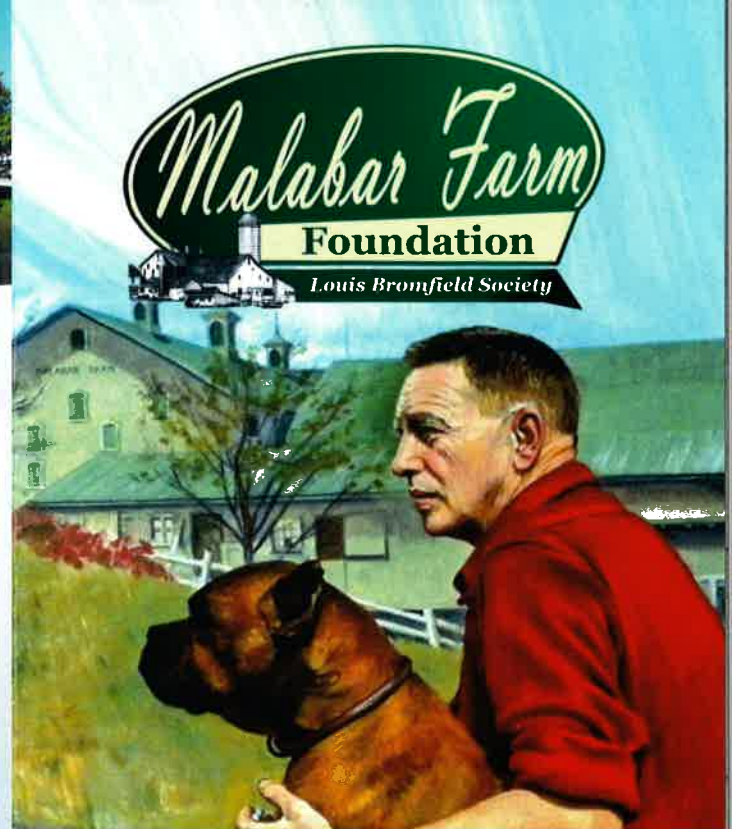
Bromfield set out on a quest to restore rich fertility to Malabar Farm by applying conservation methods that were mostly unheard of or little used at that time. Bromfield shared these conservation methods with people from all over the U.S. and other countries through speaking engagements, a newspaper column, radio broadcasts, and printed materials including a series of non-fiction "farm" books. Louis Bromfield passed away in 1956 at the age of 59.

Malabar Farm became a State Park in 1976 and hosts thousands of visitors each year, who take in the natural beauty that Malabar has to offer.

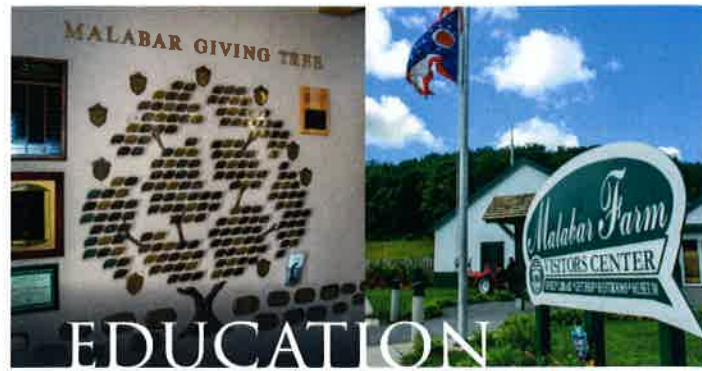
